WHAT DOES THE NHS APP DO!

Use the NHS App to:

- PLEASE ENSURE YOUR NOTIFICATIONS ARE ENABLED TO RECEIVE MESSAGES FROM THE SURGERY
- check your symptoms
- appointment reminders
- find out what to do when you need help urgently
- book and manage appointments at your GP surgery
- order repeat prescriptions
- view your GP medical record securely
- register to be an organ donor
- · choose how the NHS uses your data

Patients can turn notifications on/off by clicking on the 'Account' icon on the top right corner > 'Settings' > '<u>Manage notifications</u>' > 'go to your device settings'. Here you can select the toggle to 'Allow notifications'.

FOR PATIENTS ABOUT THE WEIGHT LOSS DRUG TIRZEPATIDE (MOUNJARO®)

Please **do not contact your GP** if you think you are eligible as it will not be available in Derby and Derbyshire until later in the year.

The ICB will publish more information on this page once a service has been set up explaining who can access it and how this can happen.

There are clear rules about which patients can get tirzepatide (Mounjaro®) from primary care.

Eligible groups will be phased, the initial priority criteria are as follows:

You must have a BMI (Body Mass Index) of 40 plus* and four or more of the following diagnosed health conditions:

- √ type 2 diabetes
- √ high blood pressure
- ✓ heart disease
- ✓ obstructive sleep apnoea

✓ abnormal blood fats (dyslipidaemia)

(* We use a lower BMI threshold - usually reduced by 2.5 kg/m2 - for people from South Asian, Chinese, other Asian, Middle Eastern, Black African or African-Caribbean ethnic backgrounds.)

TRAINING WITHIN THE PRACTICE
